## UGM | Awards 2018

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At the annual User Group Meeting this year, a “job well done moment” at the event was the awards ceremony. Awards were given to states that achieved success in building and utilizing their immunization systems to improve the outcomes of their populations.

This year’s awards, “The Power of Analytics” were given in three areas as determined by immunization intelligence developed from each state’s IIS (Immunization Information System) data. An IIS is a significant health data asset for a state and the use and value of information that is being collected is increasing daily. This data, plus the immunization intelligence when utilized, will positively impact outcomes and create ROI (Return on Investment) for stronger public-private partnerships leading to support for ongoing sustainment and the creation of third generation IIS3.

At the STC event, the three categories were: (1) the number/percent of state providers utilizing EHRs (Electronic Health Records) to capture and electronically report to the state IIS, (2) a demographics excellence award for patients under age 18, capturing the total immunization provided to this population, and (3) the state’s STC developed National Flu Score determined by combining childhood and adult influenza coverage rates for 2017-2018 with this year’s influenza vaccine efficacy rate and comparing to the suggested a 2025 STC US NFS goal.
